I write to share with you the enclosed copy of the “Singapore Cooperation Programme (SCP) Calendar for FY2024. This booklet gives an overview of the various training programmes offered under the SCP managed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Singapore.

The SCP was established in 1992 as the platform through which Singapore shares its developmental experience with other developing countries. To date, the SCP has trained more than 150,000 officials from over 180 countries, territories, and intergovernmental organisations, and is integral to our efforts to strengthen international cooperation and partnerships here at the United Nations. The SCP also fully supports the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and promotes South-South cooperation.

In 2024, the SCP hopes to assist participants to be “Future-Ready” with a focus on skill-sets to navigate a changing world, anticipate trends, as well as adapt policies and strategies to deal with emerging technologies and evolving challenges. Our courses have been curated in seven priority areas – Sustainability; Digitalisation; Education, Leadership & Governance; Public Health; National Resilience; Trade & Economy; and Connectivity. We have also introduced new courses on areas such as FinTech governance, start-up ecosystems, artificial intelligence, and aviation sustainability, which we believe are vital for a Future-Ready economy. We have aligned this focus with our collective efforts at the UN to accelerate the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), ahead of the Summit of the Future this year and as we chart the way forward towards the 2030 Agenda and beyond.
